#### SURGERY

The Pet Vet is proud to be one of the few veterinary hospitals in the Rivertown area to offer laser surgical services, starting with our new state-of-the-art SL-4980 surgical CO2 laser. Our laser utilizes 10,600nm Lumos laser technology to optimize hemostasis at a thin extinction depth. This lets us perform routine surgical procedures while reducing pain and discomfort for our patients.

### DENTISTRY

The Pet Vet provides dental cleanings for our patients to reduce incidence of periodontitis and bad breath. We use a DentalDog Supreme-FN-6500 ultrasonic scaler to remove plaque and tartar build-up. With a 30,000-rpm rotating handpiece, our equipment provides the best possible care for your pets.
