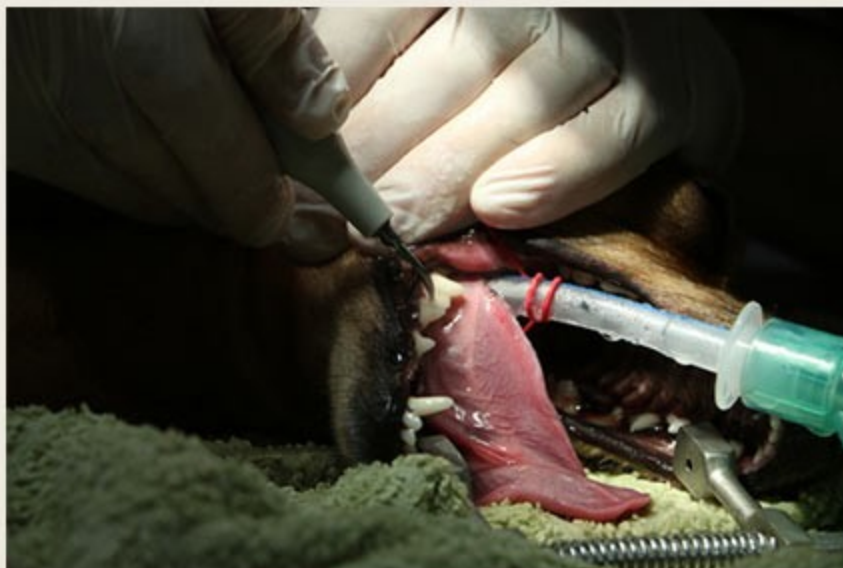

Services

Surgery

Averie Animal Hospital performs pre-anesthetic blood work on all surgery patients to ensure they are healthy enough for the surgery. A technician will monitor your pet's vital signs (heart rate, respiratory rate, temperature, blood pressure, etc.) throughout the procedure. We perform a range of surgical procedures, including spays and neuters, mass removals, fracture repairs, and emergency surgeries.



Dental

We also perform professional teeth cleanings for your pets. Just like your dentist, we scale and polish each tooth to clean them and prevent the formation of plaque and gingivitis. We take digital x-rays to look at the health of the teeth under the gums, and can perform extractions if required. All dental procedures are done under general anesthesia, and your pet's vital signs are monitored the whole time.
