



## Managing Pop Up Blockers


For optimal use of this course pop-up blockers may need to be turned off. From time to time a user may click on a link and it appears nothing happens. Depending on your browser, a closer look will show a small icon in the address bar such as this example from Chrome:



or an indicator bar as seen in this example from Firefox:




Edge, Safari and Internet Explorer act in a similar way. Clicking on the pop-up indicator will provide a menu which will allow you to accept pop-ups from the site similar to this image:




If you need to or prefer to allow popups using your browser settings, you can use your browser's Help menu to see the most current instructions by searching for popup. Below are screen shots of where to find the settings for several common browsers.

### Chrome


1. From the menu (indicated by three small dots in the upper right of the window), select **Settings**. (Keyboard: Command-Comma)



2. From Settings choose **Privacy and security**. (Use Tab+Enter to navigate.)




3. From the Privacy and security window, choose **Site Settings**. (Use Tab+Enter to navigate.)




## Chrome, cont'd


4. Scroll down to Content and select **Popups and redirects**. (Use Tab+Enter to navigate.)




5. Click the **Add** link and enter <https://www.spscourses.com>, then click the **Add** button.



3. Scroll down to the Permissions section. (Keyboard: tabbing and down-arrow)
4. Select the **Exceptions** button, next to the "block pop-up windows" checkbox.




5. Enter <https://www.spscourses.com> into the bar and select **Allow**. (Keyboard: Enter on Allow)




## Firefox


1. From the menu, select **Settings**. (Keyboard: Command-Comma to open general listbox.)



2. Choose the **Privacy and Security** option. (Keyboard: Select Enter on General and then down-arrow to Privacy & Security.)




6. Select **Save Changes**. (Keyboard: space bar Enter to Save Changes.)




## Safari


1. From the main Safari menu, choose **Preferences**.  
(Keyboard: Command-Comma to open the Preferences toolbar.)




2. From the Preferences menu, select **Websites**.  
(Keyboard: tab to navigate and spacebar to select.)



3. In the Websites tab, select **Pop-up Windows**.  
(Interact with the scroll bar using the up/down-arrows to select Pop-up Windows.)




4. The resulting box will list currently open windows. Change the setting for **spscourses.com** to **Allow**.  
(Interact with the scroll bars using up/down arrows and Voiceover keys in the Preferences table.)




## Microsoft Edge


1. From the main Edge menu, choose **Settings**.  
(Keyboard: tab, enter, and up/down arrow to navigate.)



2. Within the Settings window, choose **Cookies and Site Permissions**.  
(Keyboard: tab, enter, and up/down arrow to navigate.)




3. From the Cookies and Site Permissions section, choose **Pop-ups and Redirects**.  
(Keyboard: tab, enter, and up/down arrow to navigate.)



4. In the Allow section, select the **Add** button.  
(Keyboard: tab and enter to navigate.)




5. Enter **https://www.spscourses.com** into the bar and select **Add**.  
(Keyboard: tab, enter)




## Internet Explorer


1. From the Settings menu, select **Internet Options**.



2. From Internet Options select **Privacy**.



3. Within the Pop-up Blocker section select **Settings**.
